

Psalms 127:1 – Except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it: Except the Lord keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain.

We are the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit. He comes and dwells within us when we receive Jesus Christ as our Saviour. We become the house/temple of the Holy Spirit.

It is the Lord that builds this house. If we labour to build this house, it is only in vain. We will accomplish nothing. We are not assigned to build this house.

We are required only to yield to the Holy Spirit daily and to allow him to establish, to root and ground us as he builds this house. Our roots then begin to grow deep in Christ.

If we do not surrender daily to the Holy Spirit, we will end up trying on our own capacity to do this work. This is considered dead works to the Lord.

Let the Lord build your house. When he builds, he builds on the unmoveable rock, the rock of ages! Then when storms come, your house will still be standing. It will survive any storm and will stay intact.
